- Burden the church to pray regularly for our public officials.
- Call godly Christians to lives of public service.
- Protect public officials from the attacks of Satan.

Work Together for Common Good

Ask God to...

- Cause public officials to use their offices for the public good not personal gain.
- Give public officials wisdom to know what is in the community and nation's best interest.
- Burden churches to help public officials work toward good goals.

God to Burden Christians to Run for Office
